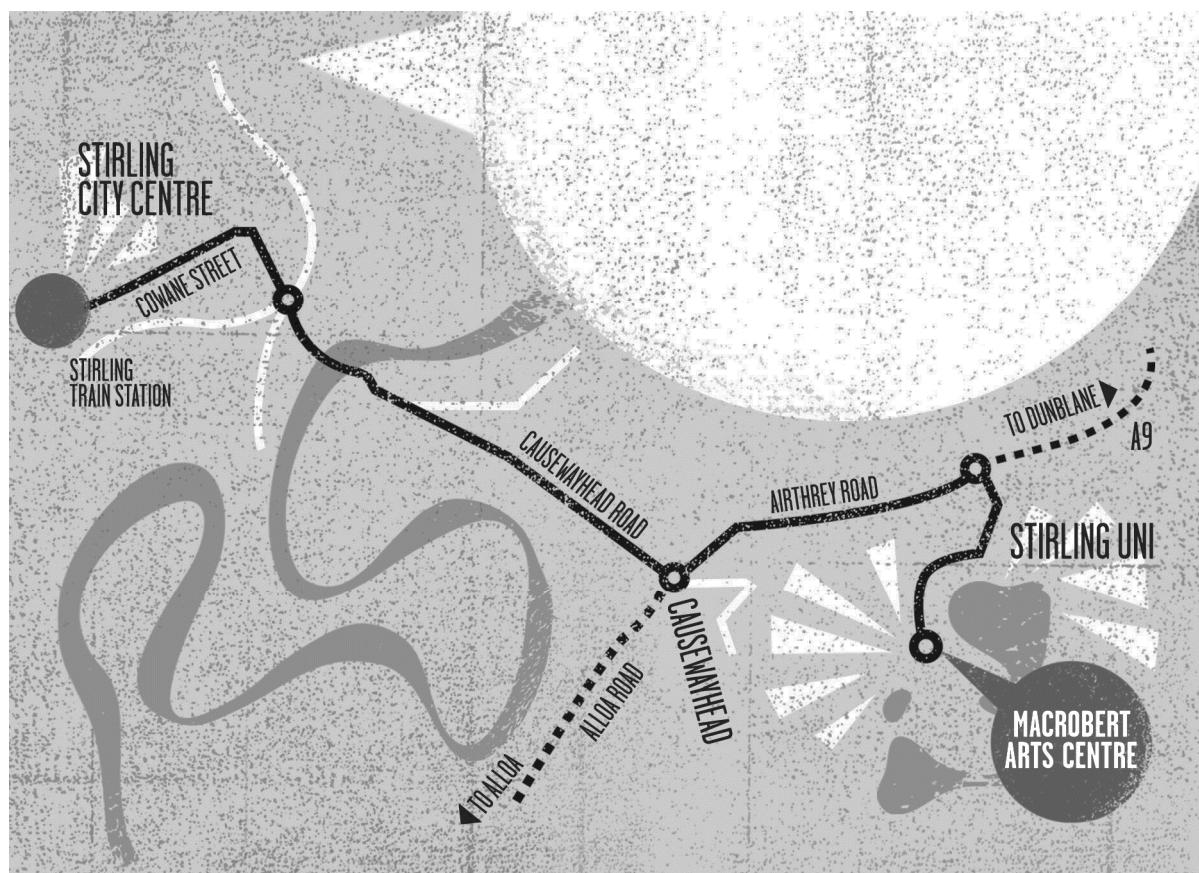
The cost for the session is £5.00 / accompanying loved one/carer free.
