

Health and Loneliness Roadshows 2015

Research shows that loneliness has a similar negative effect on health as smoking 15 cigarettes a day – and is more detrimental than obesity.



It is also recognised as a major factor contributing to health inequalities.



The impact of loneliness on health and social care services is massive yet there is still no clear strategy in place to tackle it effectively.



Befriending Networks' **Health and Loneliness Roadshows 2015** aim to offer both **practitioners** and **managers** within **health and social care services** across Scotland the opportunity to come together and discuss loneliness.

Coming to all 14 health board areas of the country, the **Roadshows** are **free** 2-hour lunchtime workshops plus a networking half hour at the end, which will provide participants with:

- ❖ research and data on the health impacts of loneliness
