Half and Full Day Courses

HIV Awareness Training – CPD Certified 17 Feb / 17 March / 20 April, 10am – 4pm This all-day introduction will help you learn how HIV transmission can be prevented, understand the support needs of people living with or at risk of HIV, and increase your confidence in speaking to others about the issues surrounding the virus such as treatment, stigma and discrimination.

Women & HIV

12 January, 9:30am – 1pm
This half-day course will help you understand and respond to the particular needs of those women who are most at risk of HIV infection and ways to support highrisk groups. This course also includes advice on how to support women who are formula feeding due to their HIV status.

Sexual Health & Dementia

The PDA in HIV at SCQF level 7 is ideal for anyone who works in healthcare, social care, sexual health, or HIV. The course is also relevant to anyone who supports at-risk populations or high prevalence communities. This course is comprised of two units.

- Unit 1: An Introduction

Unit 1 will involve one full day of training and the completion of a take-home assignment.

- Unit 2: Treatment & Lifestyle Management

(27 Feb / 26 April)

Unit 2 will involve one full day of training and the completion of a take-home assignment.
