International Certificate in Intergenerational Practice (ICIP)

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Generations Working Together and the **Macrosad Chair in Intergenerational Studies (University of Granada)** have partnered to develop the first global international certificate in intergenerational studies.

This is a unique online course, where students are assigned an expert individual tutor who works with them one to one, along with a cohort to increase peer to peer learning.

The course is aimed at those either already working in intergenerational activities, or beginning to develop their ideas and is perfect for practitioners seeking to continue their professional development in the field of intergenerational learning.

This course runs 2-3 times each year and involves three modules which take around 75 hours to complete over 8 weeks. 30 hrs will be spent working through online materials and 45 hrs carrying out activities away from the platform.

Since 2018, the course has trained almost 200 professionals from 14 countries and is accredited by the CPD Standards Office and Generations Working Together.
