



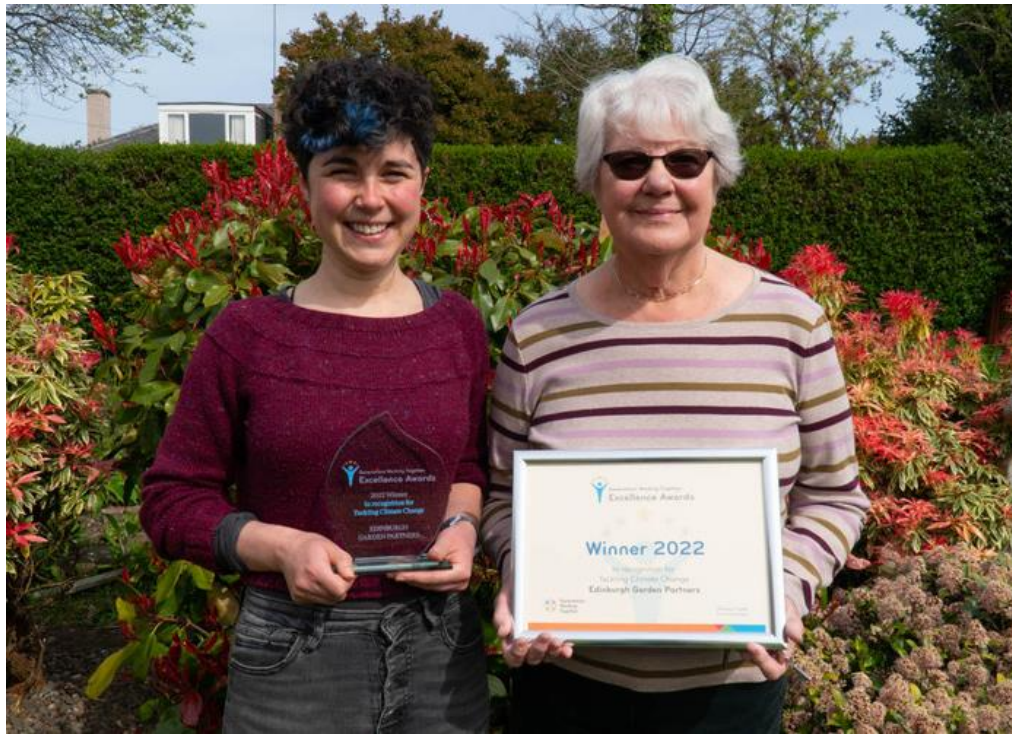

# Definition



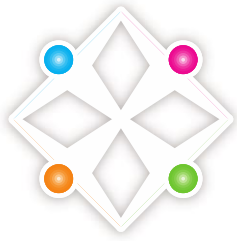
Intergenerational practice aims to bring people together in purposeful, mutually beneficial activities which promote greater understanding and respect between generations and contributes to building more cohesive communities.

- Deliver their work in Scotland (Awards 1 – 5).
- Be following the core principles of intergenerational work.
- Involve people from different generations.
- Captured the relational change between generations.

Your project should:

- Have clear aims and goals and be well planned.
- Have a clear rationale for adopting an IG approach
- Meet the needs of all participants.
- Focus on generational relationships
- Evidence the impact of the project.
- Have a sustainability strategy.
- Be innovative; and lie on the Kaplan Levels continuum.

04

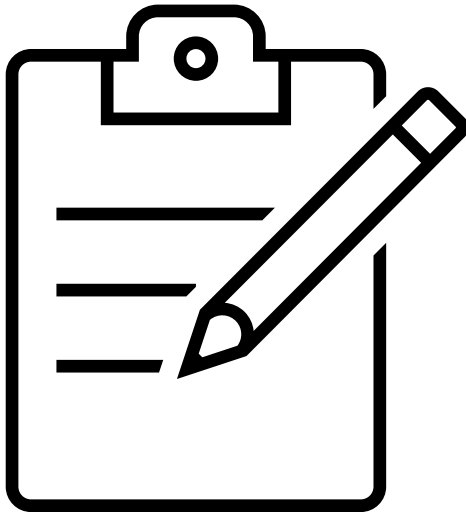
Application form must come with three high resolution photographs (consented for GWT use)

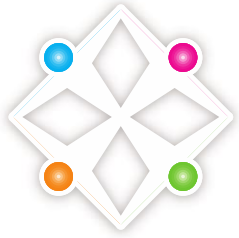
