Evaluation can only be carried out by independent organisations

Evaluation can be carried out by everyone!

Evaluation and monitoring tools are complicated and costly

Evaluation and monitoring tools are simple, easy to use and free!

Evaluation is carried out at the end of your project

Monitoring and evaluation should be discussed in the planning stage!



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Helpful definitions

Evaluation: Involves using information to make judgements on how a project, activity, or programme is doing. Evaluation can be done internally or externally.

Impact: The demonstrable contribution that social activities make to society and the economy ... embracing all diverse ways that those activities benefit individuals, organisations, communities and nations.

Monitoring: The regular recording of activities taking place in a project or programme. It is a process of routinely gathering information on all aspects of the project.



Why do we need to monitor & evaluate our intergenerational work?

- Reflect on existing intergenerational practice
- To ensure we are meeting our aims
- To provide feedback
- To secure time & resources to keep going
- To show benefits, impact & difference
- To give value to what we do



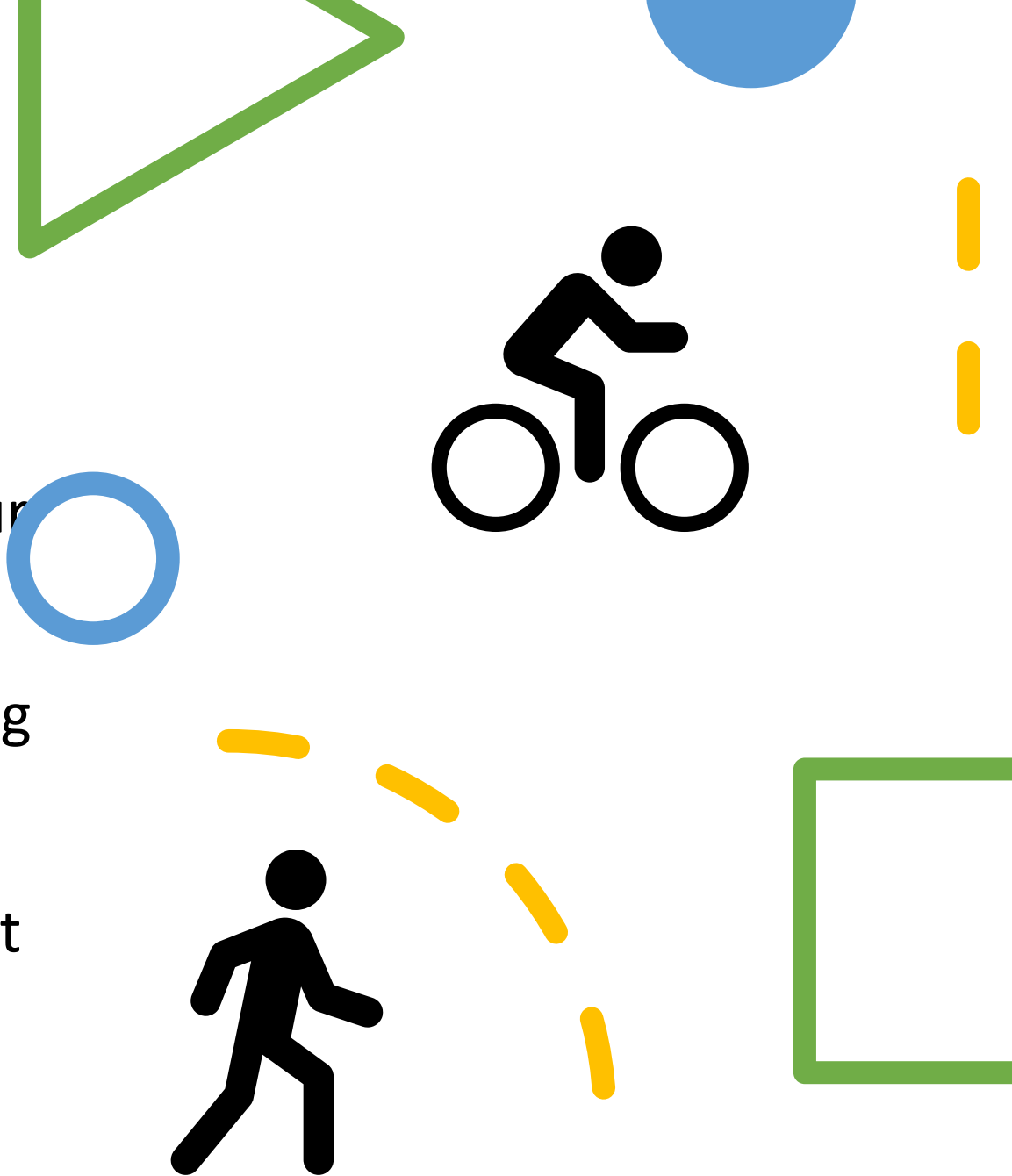


Evaluation & monitoring tools
