Our campaign posts reached an average of 1200 people on Instagram and TikTok communities, representing an impressive increase of 180% compared to pre-campaign engagement.











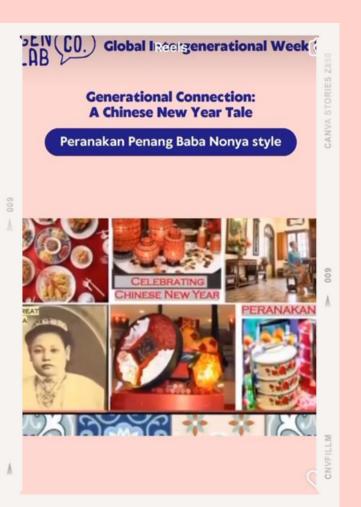

CórimAZ shared about making use of music as the key vehicle to generating connections between seniors and youths, and how they especially focus on working with seniors with dementia.



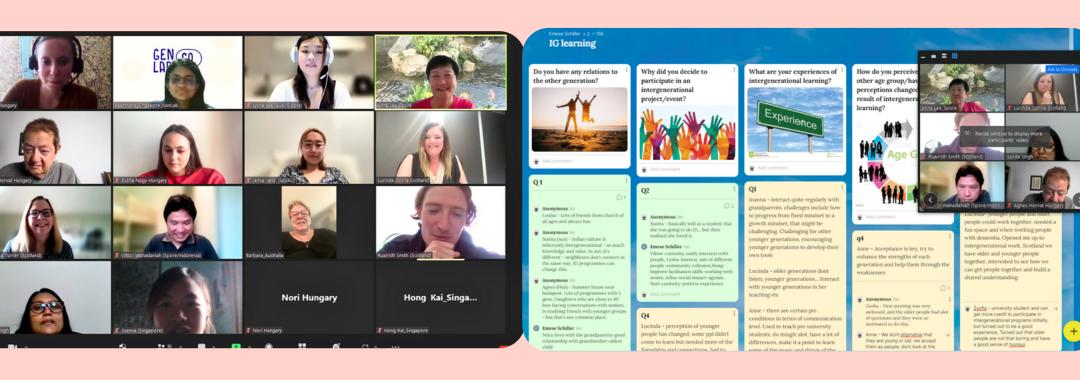
